

# Website Cookie Policy

This policy (the "Cookie Policy") provides comprehensive and transparent information about the use of cookies and other tracking technologies on the website <https://www.tsgitsystems.com/en/> (hereinafter, the "Website"), operated by TSG IT Advanced Systems Ltd ("TSG", "we", "our", or "us").

1. The Website uses cookies, both temporary or permanent, as well as web beacons and similar tracking technologies (hereinafter, collectively: "Cookies") for analyzing Website usage patterns, updating and improving questionnaires, troubleshooting, managing, and operating the Website, improving the user experience and browsing experience, control and information security purposes, details verification and user identification, preventing fraud and deception, marketing, and optimization of the Website's performance, and any other purpose aimed at improving the operation of the Website and the Service offered therein.
2. Cookies are text files created by your browser, and by using the Website you consent to their use and storage on your computer or device (to the extent they are not already stored). The information collected through Cookies relates, inter alia, to the pages you visited, the websites that referred you to the Website, the duration of time you browsed the Website, the sections of the Website in which you were interested, the type of device, and is also used for statistics and reports regarding the use of the Website and its various parts. We use both first-party cookies and third-party cookies - which are cookies from a domain different than the domain of the Website you are visiting.
3. Some Cookies are deleted when you close your browser, while others are stored on your computer's hard drive. If your browser settings allow, you may choose to refuse the use of Cookies; however, doing so may affect your ability to use the Website and to access or use some of its features.
4. You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject Cookies. *You can manage your Cookie preferences at any time by clicking on Cookie settings icon at the*

*bottom-left corner of the website.* The Cookie settings icon/link allows you to select which categories of Cookies you accept or reject. You can then adjust the available sliders to 'On' or 'Off', then clicking 'Save and close'. You may need to refresh your page for your settings to take effect. *Users can manage their cookie preferences using the Cookie Settings icon (bottom-left), which opens the CookieYes Preference Center. The Preference Center allows users to toggle cookie categories (e.g., Necessary, Analytics, Marketing) On/Off and save their choices. Page refresh may be required depending on configuration.*

5. Additionally, you can change your cookies settings through your browser. Some web browsers allow control of most cookies through the browser settings. To disable Cookies and limit the collection and use of information through Cookies, you can set your browser to refuse Cookies or indicate when a Cookie is being sent. The opt-out Cookie is browser and device specific and will only last until Cookies are cleared from your browser or device.
6. Please note that if you block cookies, you will not be able to use all the features on our Website.
7. We use several types of cookies:

7.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the Website to function and cannot be switched off in our systems. Strictly necessary Cookies help make our Website usable by enabling basic functions such as page navigation, filling in forms and access to secure areas of the website. The Website cannot function properly without these cookies.

## 7.2. Performance/Analytical Cookies

These Cookies allow us to collect performance data about our Website, to count visits and traffic sources, to collect information on how visitors behave on our Website so we can measure and improve the performance of our Website. Among others, these Cookies provide us data on which pages are the most and least popular and how visitors move around the site, to identify first and subsequent visits, etc.

hubspotutk	HubSpot	6 months	HubSpot sets this cookie to keep track of the visitors to the website. This cookie is passed to HubSpot on form submission and used when deduplicating contacts.	First party
